# Bearfoot Ranch Birthday Parties



- 2 hour party at the farm
- 8 children (maximum)
  - Children ages 3 - 12 and/or up to 130 pounds
- \$50 per child
- 1 hour with horses:
  - Hand led horse rides, 2 to 4 horses, based on availability
  - Pet, brush, paint and decorate 2 to 3 horses
- 30 minutes in private indoor party room

## Party Information!

### How Do I Book a Party?

- Call **678-805-7433** to reserve your date!
- Parties are available Saturday afternoons at two different times;

1:00 pm - 3:00 pm     &     4:00 pm - 6:00 pm

- A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is due at time of booking. Balance is due no later than the day of the party, before the party starts.
- Liability Release Waiver - Each child's guardian will be required to complete and sign a liability release waiver. We will provide you with as many of those as needed. IF WE DO NOT HAVE A LIABILITY RELEASE WAIVER FORM COMPLETED, THAT CHILD MAY NOT RIDE.

### What Do Guests and Riders Wear?

All guests and riders must wear closed-toe footwear, no flip flops or open sandals. Entrance to the main barn will not be allowed due to safety reasons. Children riding are not required to wear boots but must have closed-toe shoes, tennis shoes are a great choice.

Helmets are required when riding. Bearfoot Ranch will provide ASTM safety certified helmets for all riders. Helmets must fit securely, so be advised that headbands, tiaras/crowns, pony tails, up-do's, hair buns, hats etc. may be removed or adjusted to

ensure a proper helmet fit. Riders that do not want to wear a helmet will not ride, no exceptions.

Long pants are recommended for comfort when riding but not required.

## **What Happens When We Arrive?**

Once your guests arrive at the party room, located at the lower barn, everyone will make their way to the main barn to meet the horses and riders will get fitted for a helmet. Once we go over our safety rules, guests and riders will brush and groom horses.

Next, we will follow our hosts and horses to the main arena where **paid riders** will ride for approximately 30 minutes. Guests can watch from outside the arena and cheer on the riders and take photos.

After the horse rides, guests will go back to the main barn to paint and decorate horses.

Now it's time for food and cake! Your guests will go to the party room for the remainder of the party, where you can enjoy your beverages, food and cake.

## **Are Food and Beverages Provided?**

- We do not provide any food or beverage items.
- Please be sure to bring food, snacks, cake and/or cupcakes, beverages (NO alcohol beverages), coolers, ice, plates, napkins, any utensils you may need, as well as a utensil for cutting and serving cake and the candles and lighter!
- Please bring beverages in pre packaged containers: bottles, cans, pouches (CapriSun) etc. Cups filled with beverages tend to spill and stain the floor.
- WE DO NOT ALLOW STERNOS. You may bring an electric hotplate to keep food warm.
- We do not provide a refrigerator.

## **Set Up, Decorations and Clean Up:**

- Set up time is 30 minutes before your party start time.
- You are welcome to bring balloons, banners, streamers, tablecloths and centerpieces to decorate.
- Tables: There are two folding 6' rectangle tables and one 48"x60" farm table.

- Chairs: 16 folding chairs are provided.
- Wall Decorations: You can use tacks or painters tape to attach decorations to the walls. No scotch tape, masking tape or packing tape (or any adhesive that will peel paint off the walls) and no nails.
- Balloons: If you bring balloons, keep them inside the party room. They might scare the horses.
- No confetti.
- Clean up time is 30 minutes after your party end time. Clean up includes removing all decorations, tablecloths, plates, cups, napkins, cutlery, food containers, gift wrap, gift bags, gift boxes and all other trash. Trash bags must be disposed of in the dumpster, located near the chicken coop.
- *Please be mindful of your party time, as there is usually another party before/after your party.*

## Parking and Restrooms:

We have a parking area by the lower barn where the party room is located. There is a porta-potty located near the chicken coop.

## Is There Anything Prohibited on the Farm?

- No tobacco or vape use; smoking/vaping/chewing
- No alcohol beverages
- No pinatas
- No confetti
- No balloons outside the party room
- Gift bags are preferred with NO metal/wire twist ties - these usually end up on the ground and are a hazard to ranch animals
- **Please DO NOT feed horses treats unless approved by your host. Many of our horses are on strict diets or have medical issues and cannot have treats. Do not feed barn cats or chickens.**
- **Please ASK before approaching or petting horses and petting or picking up barn cats and chickens to avoid bites, kicks, scratches and other injuries.**

## **Is Tipping Allowed?**

Tips and/or donations are appreciated but not expected.

## **Inclement Weather and Cancellations:**

In the event of inclement weather, riding will be done in the indoor arena and the party room is enclosed and climate controlled. In the event of severe weather, we will work with you to find a new date. If you need to cancel due to severe weather or illness, the deposit can be applied towards another party or riding activity, good within one year of the original party date.
